WHEREAS, In addition to her family and teaching, Mrs. Watson was very active in the community and with local politics, which she undoubtedly instilled in her son, Bob. She had served on the East Greenwich School Committee for eight years and was a member of the Republican Town Committee. Bob went on to serve in the General Assembly as a State Senator from 1989 until 1991, and in the House of Representatives from 1993 until his retirement in 2012. He was elected Minority Leader by his peers and served from 1998 until 2011; and

WHEREAS, Over the years the Watson's home was shared by a myriad of friends, happy times, and smiling faces. Jane Watson was the heart and soul of her family. Her wit, humor, and sincerity will forever be indelibly imprinted on the lives and in the cherished memories of her
