It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 40-8.2-7 of the General Laws in Chapter 40-8.2 entitled "Medical
 Assistance Fraud" is hereby amended to read as follows:

40-8.2-7. False statements made to gain certification. -- Whoever knowingly and 3 4 willfully makes or causes to be made, or induces, or seeks to induce the making of any false 5 statement or representation of a material fact with respect to the conditions or operation of any institution or facility in order that the institution or facility may qualify (either upon initial 6 7 certification or upon recertification) as a hospital, skilled nursing facility, intermediate care facility, or home health agency, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction thereof, 8 9 shall be fined not more than five hundred dollars (\$500) one thousand dollars (\$1,000) or 10 imprisoned for not more than six (6) months one year, or both.

11 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

This act would increase the penalties from \$500 and up to six (6) months incarceration to
\$1,000 and a year incarceration for making a false statement of a material fact with respect to the
conditions or operation of any institution or facility in order that such institution may qualify as a
hospital, nursing facility, intermediate care facility or home health agency.
This act would take effect upon passage.

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
