It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 39-2 of the General Laws entitled "Duties of Utilities and Carriers"

2 is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:

<u>39-2-26. Services provided. – (a) Any public utility providing phone, cable television, or</u>

4 broadband internet service to seventy-five percent (75%) of the eligible residents of any single

- 5 city or town shall make available said phone, cable television, or internet services to the
- 6 remaining twenty-five percent (25%) of the city or town.
- 7 (b) Any broadband service provider which provides internet service to any city or town
- 8 that is part of a school district that utilizes portable internet devices for student learning at home
- 9 and has broadband internet provided to at least twenty-five percent (25%) of the eligible residents
- 10 of any single city or town, must provide broadband internet service for all residents of the city or
- 11 <u>town.</u>
