1 WHEREAS, George "Bing" Fogarty began his career with Narragansett Electric in 1950 as a laborer at the Manchester Street Power Station, and soon thereafter became involved with the 2 3 union; and 4 WHEREAS, In 1953, Bing was elected as the Secretary of Local 310 of the Brotherhood of Utility Workers of New England, and in the succeeding fifty-five years Bing never lost an 5 election in which he was a candidate; and 6 7 WHEREAS, Over the course of his career, Bing served his brothers and sisters in a myriad of local and national positions, retiring in 2008 as the National Organizer/Representative 8 9 of the Utility Workers Union of America, AFL-CIO, and the Staff Representative for the BUW, 10 New England; and 11 WHEREAS, In the years that have passed since he first walked through the gates at 12 Manchester Street, there have been many changes to the company where he once worked, the 13 industry in which he was much involved, and the union movement that he cared so much about. 14 Yet, for sixty-two years Bing remained the one constant all parties could go to for an honest 15 assessment of the situation, a history lesson, a story supporting his reasoning, and, of course, just 16 a little bit of harassment; and WHEREAS, After a long and distinguished career of sitting across the table from 17
