It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 35-3 of the General Laws entitled "State Budget" is hereby 2 amended by adding thereto the following section: 3 35-3-28. Legislative findings. -- (a) The general assembly funds that: 4 (1) The foundation of democracy is based on a government's accountability to its 5 citizenry; (2) Enhancing government transparency enhances the democratic process; and 6 7 (3) As such, state government has the responsibility to provide easily understandable and 8 accessible information about the state's annual budget to its citizens. 9 (b) Citizens' guide to the state budget. – Beginning with the state fiscal year 2016 budget 10 as enacted, the state budget office, with input from the secretary of state's office on the language, form and presentation used, shall produce an annual citizens' guide to the state budget revenue 11 12 and expenditures. The citizens' guide shall be in a form and substance that is easily readable and 13 understandable by the general public. The citizens' guide shall include data on each department's 14 purpose and populations served; and where available, may include performance measures over 15 time, depicted in a graphic format. The citizens' guide to the state budget shall be produced and released on the secretary of state's website no later than sixty (60) days after the public release of 16 17 the annual state budget office "Budget as Enacted" report.
