It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Sections 42-64.13-6 and 42-64.13-9 of the General Laws in Chapter 42-

2 64.13 entitled "Rhode Island Regulatory Reform Act" are hereby amended to read as follows:

- 3 <u>42-64.13-6. Director of office of regulatory reform. [Effective February 1, 2015.] –</u>
- 4 (a) The office of regulatory reform shall be managed by a director of office of regulatory

5 reform who shall report to the director of the office of management and budget.

- 6 (b) The responsibilities of the director of the office of regulatory reform include, but are
- 7 <u>not limited to:</u>
- 8 (1) Providing for full municipal participation in the statewide electronic permitting
- 9 system established pursuant to § 23-27.3-108.2 by December 31, 2015;
- (2) Developing and implementing a plan to expand statewide electronic permitting to
 other permit management, inspections and programs; and

- 13 <u>encouraging municipalities to eliminate, consolidate, simplify, expedite and otherwise improve</u>
- 14 permits, permitting procedures and paperwork burdens affecting businesses, industries and other
- 15 <u>matters of economic development impact in the state.</u>

<u>42-64.13-9. Municipal regulatory liaison. --</u> Each city or town in Rhode Island may at
 its option shall designate in writing submitted to the office of regulatory reform a regulatory
 liaison who shall be charged with the responsibility of coordinating regulatory and permitting
