It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

2 hereby amended by adding thereto the following section: 3 31-27-2.10. Driving under the influence of liquor or drugs, resulting in serious 4 bodily injury. – (a) When the physical injury of any person other than the operator is caused by 5 the operation of any motor vehicle, the operator of which is under the influence of any intoxicating liquor, toluene, or any controlled substance as defined in chapter 28 of title 21 or any 6 7 combination of these, the person so operating the vehicle shall be guilty of driving under the 8 influence of liquor or drugs, resulting in physical injury. 9 (b) Any person charged with a violation of this section shall, upon conviction, be 10 imprisoned for not more than three (3) years and have his or her license to operate a motor 11 vehicle suspended for not more than one year. 12 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
