It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 42-17.1-2.5 of the General Laws in Chapter 42-17.1 entitled
"Department of Environmental Management" is hereby amended to read as follows:

<u>42-17.1-2.5.</u> Tolling of expiration periods. -- (a) Notwithstanding any other provision set forth in this chapter, all periods pertaining to the expiration of any approval or permit issued pursuant to any state statute or any regulation promulgated thereto pertaining to the development of property shall be tolled until <u>June 30, 2015 June 30, 2016</u>. For the purposes of this section, "tolling" means the suspension or temporary stopping of the running of the applicable permit or approval period.

- (b) Said tolling need not be recorded in the land evidence records to be valid; however, a notice of the tolling must be posted in the municipal planning department and near the land evidence records.
- (c) The tolling shall apply only to approvals or permits in effect on November 9, 2009 and those issued between November 9, 2009 and June 30, 2015 June 30, 2016 and shall not revive expired approvals or permits.
- (d) The expiration dates for all permits and approvals issued before the tolling period began will be recalculated as of July 1, 2015 July 1, 2016 by adding thereto the number of days between November 9, 2009 and the day on which the permit or approval would otherwise have expired. The expiration dates for all permits and approvals issued during the tolling period will be

4	SECTION 2. Section 45-23-63.1 of the General Laws in Chapter 45-23 entitled

6	45-23-63.1. Procedure Tolling of expiration periods (a) Notwithstanding any
7	other provision set forth in this chapter, all periods pertaining to the expiration of any approval
8	issued pursuant to the local regulations promulgated under this chapter shall be tolled until June
9	30, 2015 June 30, 2016. For the purposes of this section, "tolling" shall mean the suspension or
10	temporary stopping of the running of the applicable permit or approval period.
11	(b) Said tolling need not be recorded in the land evidence records to be valid; however, a
12	notice of the tolling must be posted in the municipal planning department and near the land
13	evidence records.
14	(c) The tolling shall apply only to approvals or permits in effect on November 9, 2009
15	and those issued between November 9, 2009 and June 30, 2015 June 30, 2016, and shall not
16	revive expired approvals.
17	(d) The expiration dates for all permits and approvals issued before the tolling period
18	began will be recalculated as of July 1, 2015 July 1, 2016 by adding thereto the number of days

24	SECTION 3. Section 45-24-61.1 of the General Laws in Chapter 45-24 entitled "Zoning
25	Ordinances" is hereby amended to read as follows:
26	45-24-61.1. Procedure Tolling of expiration periods (a) Notwithstanding any
27	other provision set forth in this chapter, all periods pertaining to the expiration of any approval
28	issued pursuant to the local ordinances promulgated under this chapter shall be tolled until June
29	30, 2015 June 30, 2016. For the purposes of this section, "tolling" shall mean the suspension or
30	temporary stopping of the running of the applicable permit or approval period.
31	(b) Said tolling need not be recorded in the land evidence records to be valid, however, a
32	notice of the tolling must be posted in the municipal planning department, and near the land
33	evidence records.
34	(c) The tolling shall apply only to approvals or permits in effect on November 9, 2009

and those issued between November 9, 2009 and June 30, 2015 June 30, 2016 and shall not revive expired approvals.

- (d) The expiration dates for all permits and approvals issued before the tolling period began will be recalculated as of July 1, 2015 July 1, 2016 by adding thereto the number of days between November 9, 2009 and the day on which the permit or approval would otherwise have expired. The expiration dates for all permits and approvals issued during the tolling period will be recalculated as of July 1, 2015 July 1, 2016 by adding thereto the number of days between the day the permit or approval was issued and the day the permit or approval otherwise would have expired.
- SECTION 4. Section 46-23-6.3 of the General Laws in Chapter 46-23 entitled "Coastal Resources Management Council" is hereby amended to read as follows:
 - <u>46-23-6.3. Tolling of expiration periods. --</u> (a) Notwithstanding any other provision set forth in this chapter, all periods pertaining to the expiration of any approval or permit issued pursuant to any state statute or any regulation promulgated thereto pertaining to the development of property shall be tolled until <u>June 30, 2015 June 30, 2016</u>. For the purposes of this section, "tolling" means the suspension or temporary stopping of the running of the applicable permit or approval period.
 - (b) Said tolling need not be recorded in the land evidence records to be valid, however, a notice of the tolling must be posted in the municipal planning department and near the land evidence records.
 - (c) The tolling shall apply only to approvals or permits in effect on November 9, 2009 and those issued between November 9, 2009 and June 30, 2015 June 30, 2016, and shall not revive expired approvals or permits.
