It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1	SECTION 1. Section 31-22-22.1 of the General Laws in Chapter 31-22 entitled
2	"Miscellaneous Rules" is hereby repealed.
3	31-22-22.1. Child passenger protection Warnings of hazard and risk (a) All law
4	enforcement officers in this state are authorized to provide a verbal warning to any person who
5	shall be deemed to have left a child under the age of seven (7) unattended in a motor vehicle. The
6	warning shall apprise the offending person of the dangers of this practice including, but not
7	limited to, the risk of kidnapping and/or abduction, and the dangers which may result from the
8	accumulation of excessive temperatures within the motor vehicle.
9	(b) No fine or sanction shall be imposed for a violation of this section, other than a
10	verbal warning, and no record of any kind shall be maintained of the warning.
11	SECTION 2. Chapter 31-22 of the General Laws entitled "Miscellaneous Rules" is
12	hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
13	31-22-22.2. Child passenger protection. – (a) It shall be a violation for any person in
14	control of a motor vehicle to leave a child under the age of seven (7) unattended in a motor
15	vehicle.
16	(b) Any person charge with a violation of this section shall, upon conviction, be fined not
17	more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000), and may have his or her license to operate a motor
18	vehicle suspended for not more than three (3) years.

EXPLANATION

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

OF

AN ACT

RELATING TO MOTOR AND OTHER VEHICLES -- MISCELLANEOUS RULES

This act would make it an offense to leave a child under seven (7) years of age unattended in a motor vehicle, punishable by a fine of up to one thousand dollars (\$1,000), and possible suspension of license not to exceed three (3) years.

This act would take effect upon passage.
