The warning shall apprise the offending person of the dangers of this practice including, but not 6 7 limited to, the risk of kidnapping and/or abduction, and the dangers which may result from the accumulation of excessive temperatures within the motor vehicle. 8 9 (b) No fine or sanction shall be imposed for a violation of this section, other than a 10 verbal warning, and no record of any kind shall be maintained of the warning. SECTION 2. Chapter 31-22 of the General Laws entitled "Miscellaneous Rules" is 11 12 hereby amended by adding thereto the following section: 13 31-22-22.2. Child passenger protection. – (a) It shall be a violation for any person in 14 control of a motor vehicle to leave a child under the age of seven (7) unattended in a motor 15 vehicle. BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

This act would make it an offense to leave a child under seven (7) years of age unattended in a motor vehicle, punishable by a fine of up to one thousand dollars (\$1,000), and possible suspension of license not to exceed three (3) years.
