It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 5-53.1-12.1 of the General Laws in Chapter 5-53.1 entitled 2 "Solicitation by Charitable Organizations" is hereby amended to read as follows: 3 5-53.1-12.1. Solicitation -- Requirements. -- Prior to orally requesting a contribution, or contemporaneously with a written request for a contribution, regardless of how the request is 4 5 made, the following shall be clearly and conspicuously disclosed: 6 (a) The name of the professional solicitor and professional fund-raiser, the name of the entity that employed or otherwise engaged the professional solicitor or professional fund-raiser, 7 8 and the fact that the solicitation is being conducted by a professional solicitor-; and (b) If requested by the prospective donor, the The percentage of the contribution to be 9 10 retained by the professional fund-raiser or the company that employed or otherwise engaged the 11 professional fund-raiser. 12 (c) Any solicitation that is subject to this section, regardless of how the solicitation is 13 made, shall include the following statement: 14 "My name is [insert full name] and I am an employee of [insert name of fundraising company]. I am a paid representative soliciting charitable contributions on behalf of [insert name 15 of charitable organization]. I am required by Rhode Island law to inform you that [insert name of 16
