1 RESOLVED, That a special legislative commission be and the same is hereby created 2 consisting of seven (7) members: seven (7) of whom shall be members of the Rhode Island House 3 of Representatives, not more than five (5) from the same political party, to be appointed by the 4 Speaker of the House. In lieu of any appointment of a member of the legislature to a permanent advisory 5 6 commission, a legislative study commission, or any commission created by a General Assembly 7 resolution, the appointing authority may appoint a member of the general public to serve in lieu 8 of a legislator, provided that the majority leader or the minority leader of the political party which 9 is entitled to the appointment consents to the member of the general public. 10 The purpose of said commission shall be to make a comprehensive study of all matters 11 relating to sex trafficking in the State of Rhode Island. 12 Forthwith upon passage of this resolution, the members of the commission shall meet at 13 the call of the Speaker of the House and organize and shall select a chairperson from among the 14 legislators. 15 Vacancies in said commission shall be filled in like manner as the original appointment. 16 The membership of said commission shall receive no compensation for their services. All departments and agencies of the state, shall furnish such advice and information, 17 18 documentary and otherwise, to said commission and its agents as is deemed necessary or

desirable by the commission to facilitate the purposes of this resolution.
