It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 28-9.1-13 of the General Laws in Chapter 28-9.1 entitled 2 "Firefighters' Arbitration" is hereby amended to read as follows:

3 28-9.1-13. Request for collective bargaining. -- Whenever wages, rates of pay, or any 4 other matter requiring appropriation of money by any city or town are included as a matter of 5 collective bargaining conducted under the provisions of this chapter, it is the obligation of the bargaining agent to serve written notice of request for collective bargaining on the corporate 6 7 authorities at least one hundred twenty (120) days before the last day on which money can be 8 appropriated by the city or town to cover the contract period which is the subject of the collective 9 bargaining procedure the expiration of the collective bargaining procedure. 10

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

1 This act would require that when wages or rates of pay for firefighters require an 2 appropriation of money by a municipality and are subject to collective bargaining, the bargaining 3 agent would be required to serve written notice of a request for collective bargaining at least one 4 hundred twenty (120) days prior to the expiration of the collective bargaining agreement. 5 This act would take effect upon passage.
