It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 13-6-1 of the General Laws in Chapter 13-6 entitled "Loss of
Rights by Prisoners" is hereby amended to read as follows:

3 13-6-1. Life prisoners deemed civilly dead. -- Every person imprisoned in the adult correctional institutions for life shall, with respect to all rights of property, to the bond of 4 5 matrimony and to all civil rights and relations of any nature whatsoever, except the bond of 6 matrimony, be deemed to be dead in all respects, as if his or her natural death had taken place at 7 the time of conviction. However, the bond of matrimony shall not be dissolved, nor shall the 8 rights to property or other rights of the husband or wife of the imprisoned person be terminated or impaired, except on the entry of a lawfully obtained decree for divorce. 9 10 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
