## HOUSE RESOLUTION

# HONORING JAMES KAREEMO ON THE AUSPICIOUS OCCASION OF HIS 80TH BIRTHDAY

1 WHEREAS, James Kareemo, better known as "Jimmy", was born eight decades ago on March 28th of 1936. The country was finally coming out of the Great Depression under the 2 3 Presidency of Franklin Delano Roosevelt, the cost of bread was 8¢ a loaf, and the average salary 4 was \$1,600 a year; and WHEREAS, In 1963, Mr. Kareemo joined the Pawtucket Police Force as a Patrolman. 5 His compassion and involvement with the neighborhoods he patrolled was renowned and he 6 7 quickly earned a reputation as an officer who had an innate ability to handle problems and truly 8 cared about the people he protected; and 9 WHEREAS, During his years on the force, Mr. Kareemo faced many life and death 10 situations, as do many of our brave men in blue, but few as dangerous as the early morning hours 11 following his 41st birthday. After having served a full day shift, Mr. Kareemo was working on the 12 Family Crisis Team, which counsels runaways, suicides and family disputes. He was called on 13 what was thought to be a "routine" call, but immediately upon arriving at the scene, he was 14 stabbed seven times by a 19 year old assailant who was involved in a domestic dispute at the 15 address; and WHEREAS, Although gravely wounded, Officer Kareemo was still able to fire four 16 shots, wounding his assailant in the arm and making possible his subsequent arrest. He was 17

awarded the Attorney General's Law Enforcement Award, the City of Pawtucket's Blue Star

Award, and the National Law Enforcement Military Order of the Purple Heart Award for his

Over the last eighty years, he has impacted the lives of so many people with his wealth of knowledge, his wonderful demeanor, and his exuberance for life, and all who are lucky enough to be a part of his extraordinary life are proud to call him their friend; now, therefore be it
