Statewide solar permitting. -- (a) No later than December 31, 2016, the office of regulatory reform in consultation with the task force established in subsection (b) of this 4 5 section, shall prepare and submit to the governor, the senate president and the speaker of the 6 house, a report with recommendations for a statewide permitting process for small residential and 7 small commercial roof-top solar projects. 8 (b) The office of regulatory reform shall establish a task force and appoint members and, at a minimum, shall include: 9 10 (1) The commissioner of the office of energy resources, or designee; 11 (2) At least five (5) municipal representatives; and 12 (3) A representative from a clean energy regional business association. 13 (c) Implementation. The commissioner of the office of energy resources in consultation 14 with the director of the office of regulatory reform shall submit to the governor, the senate president, and the speaker of the house, proposed legislation establishing a statewide permitting 15 16 process as recommended in the report issued pursuant to subsection (a) of this section no later
