CONGRATULATING MEMBERS OF THE BISHOP HENDRICKEN ACADEMIC DECATHLON TEAM ON TAKING SECOND PLACE IN THE 2016-2017 UNITED STATES ACADEMIC DECATHLON® NATIONAL FINALS DIVISION II

1 WHEREAS, It is fitting that this House recognizes those students who, through their 2 knowledge and unflagging commitment to excellence, have academically distinguished 3 themselves, their school, and our state; and WHEREAS, The United States Academic Decathlon® (USAD), consists of 32 state 4 5 winners from across the country, as well as 16 international teams, competing in a ten-event, team-based scholastic competition wherein students match their intellect with students from 6 7 across the country in ten categories: Art, Economics, Essay, Interview, Language and Literature, Mathematics, Music, Science, Social Science and Speech. The schools are split into three 8 9 divisions determined by school size, and each team is divided into three categories - varsity, 10 scholastic, and honors; and 11 WHEREAS, Upon taking first place in the 2016 Rhode Island Academic Decathlon, the 12 nine members of Bishop Hendricken's Academic Decathlon team went on to represent Rhode 13 Island at the 2016-2017 USAD Nationals, held on April 28-30, in Anchorage, Alaska, and earned 14 an impressive second place finish in the Division II category; and 15 WHEREAS, Hailed as one of "the greatest achievements" in Bishop Hendricken's scholastic history, the team amassed a team total of 45,450 points out of a possible 60,000 points, 16 17 and out-scored fourteen other teams to take second place in Division II and sixth overall; and 18 WHEREAS, With the amazing performance of team MVP Riley Chabot, who alone 19 scored 8,697.3 points, the Hendricken team amassed the highest score of any Rhode Island team

2	WHEREAS, Team members garnered a total of 16 medals during the competition. The
3	medal winners are senior Riley Chabot with a bronze in music, silvers in math and literature, and
4	a gold in science; senior Miles Temel with a bronze in social science and a silver in essay; senior
5	Geoffrey Boyer with silvers in science and interview; senior Aidan Kendra with bronzes in music
6	and art, and silvers in economics and science; senior Nathan Tomasso with a bronze in essays
7	senior Nicolas Bassi with a silver in essay; junior Ryan Brady with a gold in math; and senior
8	Peter Cienki with a bronze in math; and
9	WHEREAS, Team members credit much of their success to their coach, Sister Carol Ann
10	Murray, for her unwavering dedication, guidance, and support, and for inspiring them to work as
11	hard as they could; and
12	WHEREAS, Members of the Bishop Hendricken Academic Decathlon team are most
13	certainly a tremendous source of pride not only for their parents, but also for their school and our
14	state, and they are truly deserving of our recognition and praise; now, therefore be it
15	RESOLVED, That this House of Representatives of the State of Rhode Island and
16	Providence Plantations hereby congratulates members of the Bishop Hendricken Academic
17	Decathlon Team on taking second place in the 2016-2017 United States Academic Decathlon®
18	National Finals Division II. We moreover wish them much happiness and success in all their
