It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 23-17.5-21 of the General Laws in Chapter 23-17.5 entitled "Rights
   of Nursing Home Patients" is hereby amended to read as follows:
- <u>23-17.5-21. Penalties. (a)</u> Any nursing home which refuses or neglects to post
  provisions as set forth in §23-17.5-20, or which violates the requirements of this chapter shall be
  guilty of a misdemeanor for each violation punishable by a fine of up to five hundred dollars
  (\$500) and/or six (6) months in jail.
  (b) Any person or resident whose rights, as defined in this chapter, are violated shall have

8 <u>a cause of action against the nursing home, and/or the person committing such violation. The</u>

- 9 action may be brought in a court of competent jurisdiction to enforce such rights, and to recover
- 10 actual and punitive damages for their violation. Any plaintiff who prevails in any such action
- 11 <u>shall be entitled to recover reasonable attorneys' fees and costs of the action.</u>
- 12 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
