It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 14-1 of the General Laws entitled "Proceedings in Family Court" is 2 hereby amended by adding thereto the following section: 3 14-1-5.2. Age restrictions for children. – (a) Children under ten (10) years of age shall not be left home alone. 4 5 (b) Children at least ten (10) years of age and not more than twelve (12) years of age shall 6 be allowed to stay home alone for brief periods of time, but not after 9:00 pm. 7 (c) Children over twelve (12) years of age may be left home alone, but not overnight. 8 (d) Parents and legal guardians should use their judgment to access the maturity and responsibility of their children and to discuss safety procedures and precautions before deciding 9 10 whether to leave their child(ren) home alone. 11 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
