It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 42-28.2 of the General Laws entitled "Police Officers -

2 Commission on Standards and Training" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following

3 section:

42-28.2-8.4. Educational requirements -- Crisis intervention training.

5 (a) The commission on standards and training shall prepare and publish clearly defined

6 standards for competency related to emergency certification and protocols for police officers

7 responding to, handling, investigating, and reporting all incidents involving any person requiring

8 <u>a higher level of mental health literacy. The commission shall include this universal police</u>

9 training and certification in the Mental Health First Aid USA curriculum for recruits, and

- 10 annually to every police department in the state, with an annual commitment to increasing the
- 11 <u>number of officers trained.</u>
- 12 (b) The commission shall appoint at least one member from the mental health advocacy

13 community to sit in an advisory capacity in connection with carrying out the provisions of this

- 14 <u>section and any other related mental health issues.</u>
- 15 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

EXPLANATION

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
