Arrestees--Voting by provisional ballot. 4 (a) Any person who has been arrested and held for any period of time in any facility, 5 including jails, prisons, cell blocks, or hospitals on the date of any state or federal primary or general election shall be notified of and afforded the opportunity to vote by provisional ballot in 6 7 accordance with §17-19-24.1. 8 (b) Any person who has been arrested and held in any facility including jails, prisons, cell 9 blocks, or hospitals within sixty (60) days of a federal or state primary or general election shall be 10 notified of and afforded the opportunity to register to vote and/or apply for a mail ballot with the

assistance of the division of sheriffs through regulations promulgated by the board of elections in

12 <u>accordance with the procedures relating to registration of voters in chapter 9.1 of title 17 and mail</u>

ballots in chapter 20 of title 17.

(c) The board of elections and the division of sheriffs shall formulate and promulgate

rules and regulations in order to carry out the provisions of this section.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
