It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 42-28-4 of the General Laws in Chapter 42-28 entitled "State

Police" is hereby amended to read as follows:

42-28-4. Composition of division.

(a) There shall be a division of state police consisting of the following members: a superintendent who shall have the rank of full colonel; as many captains as the superintendent shall deem necessary, two lieutenant colonels, three majors; as many lieutenants as the superintendent shall deem necessary; and such other personnel, the number and rank of whom shall be designated by the superintendent, and the general assembly shall annually appropriate such sum as it may deem necessary for the payment of the salaries of the members of the division. The member of the Rhode Island state police who shall be assigned by the superintendent to execute the duties of deputy superintendent shall have the rank of lieutenant colonel.

(b) The ranks of the division of state police shall reflect the diversity of the community which it serves. The superintendent of state police shall conduct a vigorous effort to recruit persons of color to the Rhode Island state police training academy and shall utilize all forms of media in this effort including, but not limited to, print and electronic media, radio and television. The recruitment effort required by this section shall include dissemination of information relating to the selection and training process for admission to the Rhode Island state police training

would also require the superintendent to conduct a vigorous effort to recruit persons of color to
the Rhode Island State Police Training Academy.

This act would take effect upon passage.
