It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 11-5 of the General Laws entitled "Assaults" is hereby amended by
- 2 adding thereto the following section:

#### 3 <u>11-5-3.1. Assault or battery upon delivery person.</u>

- 4 (a) "Delivery person" means any person engaged in the commercial delivery of any item,
- 5 <u>food product, or anything else of value to any home, residence or business.</u>
- 6 (b) Every person who shall make an assault or battery upon any delivery person in the
- 7 execution of their duty shall be imprisoned not exceeding three (3) years or fined not exceeding
- 8 three thousand dollars (\$3,000), or both.
- 9 (c) Every person who shall make an assault or battery, or both, with a dangerous weapon,
- 10 or with acid or other dangerous substance, or by fire, or an assault or battery which results in
- 11 serious bodily injury, to any delivery person shall be punished by imprisonment for a period of
- 12 <u>not less than five (5) years, but not more than twenty (20) years.</u>
- 13 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

1 This act would make assault and battery upon delivery persons a felony and would 2 mandate a maximum sentence of imprisonment of three (3) years. If a person were convicted of 3 such an assault and battery while using a dangerous weapon, the minimum sentence would be 4 imprisonment for five (5) years. 5 This act would take effect upon passage.
