It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 45-19 of the General Laws entitled "Relief of Injured and Deceased

Fire Fighters and Police Officers" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:

45-19-16.1. Presumption of cardiovascular disability in the line of firefighting duty.

4 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to the contrary, any

5 <u>firefighter</u>, as defined in §45-19-1, who is unable to perform their duties in the fire department

6 because of an impairment of health caused by hypertension, stroke or heart disease, is presumed

7 to have suffered an in-the-line-of-duty disability, as a result of the inhalation of noxious fumes or

8 poisonous gases, physically demanding work, traumatic stress, and related factors associated with

firefighting; provided however, that the person benefiting from the presumption had passed a

10 physical examination upon entry into service, which failed to reveal any evidence of the

11 <u>condition.</u>
