It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 16-11-2 of the General Laws in Chapter 16-11 entitled
"Certification of Teachers [See Title 16 Chapter 97 - The Rhode Island Board Of Education Act]"
is hereby amended to read as follows:

16-11-2. Examinations -- Issuance of certificates.

5 (a) The board of regents for council on elementary and secondary education shall hold, or 6 cause to be held, in any places in different parts of the state and at any times it may determine, 7 examinations for the position of teacher in the public schools of this state; and the board of 8 regents for council on elementary and secondary education is authorized to issue certificates of 9 qualification which shall be valid throughout the state for the grade and time specified in the 10 certificate. All assessed fees shall be deposited as general revenues.

- 11 (b) The fee for taking any examination required to be licensed and certified as a teacher
- 12 shall be waived for any teaching candidate who possesses a bachelor's degree.
- 13 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
