It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 5-20-38 of the General Laws in Chapter 5-20 entitled "Plumbers,
- 2 Irrigators, and Water System Installers" is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 3

5-20-38. Individual sewage disposal system (ISDS) installers -- Work permitted.

Any person who is a licensed individual sewage disposal system installer under the 4 5 provisions of chapter 56 of this title is authorized to make residential water supply connections to 6 residential dwellings consisting of three (3) units or less both public and/or private at the source 7 of the public and/or private supply for the purpose of installation, alteration, and/or repair. Water 8 installations, alterations and repairs mean and include the piping and connections from the source 9 of public and/or private water supply to the building or premises. Licensed individual sewage 10 disposal system installers are required to comply with city or town permits and inspection 11 requirements as to water supply installations, alterations, and/or repairs. In no event shall licensed 12 individual sewage disposal system installers be allowed to perform any work on fittings or fixtures beyond the initial premises connection; provided, however, that a licensed individual 13 14 sewage disposal system installer may, without any further licensing being required, connect an existing individual sewage disposal system to a municipal sewer system. 15

- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
