It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 16-77 of the General Laws entitled "Establishment of Charter
Public Schools [See Title 16 Chapter 97 - The Rhode Island Board of Education Act]" is hereby
amended by adding thereto the following section:

#### 16-77-13. Sending districts to have membership on board of directors.

5 Effective July 1, 2017, charter public schools and organizations shall include on their

6 <u>board of governors or trustees elected representatives or their designees from the municipalities</u>

7 with the largest percentage of students enrolled in their school. Every school committee of any

8 public school district shall be authorized to appoint one designee or member to the board of

9 directors, trustees, or other governing body of any charter public school where students who are

10 residents of that district comprise five percent (5%) or more of the total number of students

11 enrolled in the charter public school. In the event a charter public school does not have a board of

12 governors, trustees, or similar body, such a body shall be established by each charter public

13 school or organization to ensure public representation in the supervision and expenditure of

- 14 public resources.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2017.
