WHEREAS, Christopher Nadeau of Troop 138, West Kingston, is a remarkable young
man who is eminently worthy of this prestigious achievement and his accomplishments are truly
deserving of our recognition; and

WHEREAS, Christopher began his scouting career in the first grade when he joined the Cub Scouts. Over the past eleven years, Christopher has become a responsible young man who has learned vital life skills. He has learned crucial leadership skills and to be accountable for his actions and decisions in life. He has cooked for his Troop and done the preparation work for mountain hikes. He has also served the wider community by collecting food for the less fortunate, planting flags at the Veterans Cemetery, and building community gardens, sheds and bridges for local community groups; and
