He was a member of the House Committee on Special Legislation, the Joint 7 Committee on Accounts and Claims, and was a member of the Providence Preservation Society; 8 and 9 WHEREAS, Robert Gemma has worked tirelessly for the Rhode Island State 10 Government Intern Program, serving as its Director for approximately thirty years.
