It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 27-8 of the General Laws entitled "Casualty Insurance Generally"

2 is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:

27-8-1.1. Vacant property.

4 (a) No residential property shall be declared vacant under any policy of insurance after a

5 period of thirty (30) or less days; provided, that the owner of the residential property is in the

6 process of renovation and/or rehabilitation of the premises pursuant to the issuance of the

7 appropriate building permits by the municipality wherein the property is located.

8 (b) The process of renovation and/or rehabilitation shall commence upon the date when

9 the application for the issuance of a building permit is filed and shall cease upon the date when

the renovation and/or rehabilitation is completed and a certificate of occupancy has been

obtained.

3	to building permits issued by the local municipality from the date of application for the permits to
4	the date of completion of the renovation and/or rehabilitation and the issuance of a certificate of
5	occupancy.
