| 9  | establishment.   |
| 10 | (2) "Retail establishments" means all sales outlets, stores, shops, or other places of             |
| 11 | business located within the state, which operate primarily to sell or convey foods or goods.       |
| 12 | (3) "Vehicle barrier" means a safety device that meets, at a minimum, the vehicle impact           |
| 13 | protection standards as, or to be, established by the Rhode Island building code commission, and   |
| 14 | that is installed to protect persons located within or on the property of buildings, or to protect |
| 15 | pedestrians, from collisions into those buildings by motor vehicles.                               |
