SECTION 1. Section 42-66.9-1 of the General Laws in Chapter 42-66.9 entitled

"Housing for the Elderly - Emergency Generators Required" is hereby amended to read as

42-66.9-1. Emergency generators required.

All housing for the elderly complexes, as defined in § 42-66.1-2, which are may be

6 serviced by one or more elevators and/or electrically powered chair lifts, and which include more

7 than one hundred (100) three (3) residential living units in a single building shall be equipped

8 with emergency generators which shall provide sufficient power to provide emergency lighting to

9 all common areas and a community room and power to operate the elevators and a refrigerator in

a common area. Generator systems shall be in accordance with the national electric code and §

11 23-28.24-9.

12 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
