It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 42-64 of the General Laws entitled "Rhode Island Commerce
- 2 Corporation" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 3 <u>42-64-7.14. Recreational facility exemption.</u>
- 4 Notwithstanding the express powers granted to the commerce corporation by §§ 42-64-6
- 5 and 42-64-7, the corporation shall not provide any grants, loans, or financial assistance of any
- 6 kind or nature to any business in excess of five million dollars (\$5,000,000) without general
- 7 <u>assembly approval.</u>
- 8 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

EXPLANATION

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

OF

AN ACT

RELATING TO STATE AFFAIRS AND GOVERNMENT - COMMERCE CORPORATION

This act would prohibit the state commerce corporation, without express general assembly approval, providing any grants or loans of any kind that exceed five million dollars (\$5,000,000).
