It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 9-1-14.1 of the General Laws in Chapter 9-1 entitled "Causes of
 Action" is hereby amended to read as follows:

## 9-1-14.1. Limitation on malpractice actions.

Notwithstanding the provisions of §§ 9-1-13 and 9-1-14, an action for medical,
veterinarian, accounting, or insurance or real estate agent or broker malpractice shall be
commenced within three (3) years from the time of the occurrence of the incident which gave rise
to the action; provided, however, that:

8 (1) One who is under disability by reason of age, mental incompetence, or otherwise, and 9 on whose behalf no action is brought within the period of three (3) years from the time of the 10 occurrence of the incident, shall bring the action within three (3) years from the removal of the 11 disability the action at any time up to twenty-one (21) years of age.

12 (2) One who is under disability by reason of mental incompetence, or otherwise, and on

13 whose behalf no action is brought within the period of three (3) years from the time of the

- 14 <u>occurrence of the incident, shall bring the action within three (3) years from the removal of the</u>
- 15 <u>disability.</u>

(2)(3) In respect to those injuries or damages due to acts of medical, veterinarian,
 accounting, or insurance or real estate agent or broker malpractice which could not in the exercise
 of reasonable diligence be discoverable at the time of the occurrence of the incident which gave

- 1 rise to the action, suit shall be commenced within three (3) years of the time that the act or acts of
- 2 the malpractice should, in the exercise of reasonable diligence, have been discovered.
- 3 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
