It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 45-2 of the General Laws entitled "General Powers" is hereby
- 2 amended by adding thereto the following section:

3 45-2-67. Payment of police training.

- 4 Any law enforcement agency within the state of Rhode Island that hires a law
- 5 enforcement officer working for another municipality within the state of Rhode Island shall, upon
- 6 hiring such law enforcement officer, reimburse the municipality from which it hired the officer
- 7 for all costs and expenses and expenses associated with the training and education, including
- 8 costs of uniforms, weapons and other incidental expenses, of said officer provided that said costs
- 9 of training and education were incurred within five (5) years of the date of hire.
- 10 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

EXPLANATION

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

OF

AN ACT

RELATING TO TOWNS AND CITIES - GENERAL POWERS

1 This act would require any police department that hires an officer employed by another 2 police department within the state of Rhode Island to reimburse the municipality for which the 3 officer first worked, for all costs and expenses associated with the officer's training and education

4 provided that such costs were incurred within five years of the hiring.
