It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 27-18 of the General Laws entitled "Accident and Sickness
2	Insurance Policies" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
3	27-18-27.1. Insurance coverage for annual pediatric mental health examinations.
4	(a) Every individual or group hospital or medical expense insurance policy, or individual
5	or group hospital or medical services plan contract delivered, issued for delivery, or reviewed in
6	this state on or after January 1, 2019, shall provide coverage for an annual pediatric mental health
7	examination when determined to be medically necessary and ordered by a physician or
8	pediatrician and/or any court of this state having jurisdiction of children from the age of ten (10)
9	years up to the age of eighteen (18) years.
10	(b) Benefit plans offered by an insurer may impose co-payment and/or deductibles for the
11	benefits mandated by this chapter; however, in no instance shall the co-payment or deductible
12	amount be greater than the co-payment or deductible amount imposed for physician office visits.
13	Benefits for services under this section shall be reimbursed in accordance with the respective
14	principles and mechanisms of reimbursement for each insurer, hospital, or medical service
15	corporation, or health maintenance organization.
16	SECTION 2. Chapter 27-19 of the General Laws entitled "Nonprofit Hospital Service
17	Corporations" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
18	27-19-18.1. Insurance coverage for annual pediatric mental health examinations.

Insurance coverage for annual pediatric mental health examination. 15 (a) Every individual or group hospital or medical expense insurance policy, or individual 16 or group hospital or medical services plan contract delivered, issued for delivery, or reviewed in 17 this state on or after January 1, 2019, shall provide coverage for an annual pediatric mental health 18 examination when determined to be medically necessary and ordered by a physician or 19 pediatrician and/or any court of this state having jurisdiction of children from the age of ten (10) 20 years up to the age of eighteen (18) years. 21 (b) Benefit plans offered by an insurer may impose co-payment and/or deductibles for the 22 benefits mandated by this chapter; however, in no instance shall the co-payment or deductible 23 amount be greater than the co-payment or deductible amount imposed for physician office visits. 24 Benefits for services under this section shall be reimbursed in accordance with the respective 25 principles and mechanisms of reimbursement for each insurer, hospital, or medical service 26 corporation, or health maintenance organization. Insurance coverage for annual pediatric mental health examination. 30 (a) Every individual or group hospital or medical expense insurance policy, or individual 31 or group hospital or medical services plan contract delivered, issued for delivery, or reviewed in 32 this state on or after January 1, 2019, shall provide coverage for an annual pediatric mental health 33 examination when determined to be medically necessary and ordered by a physician or pediatrician and/or any court of this state having jurisdiction of children from the age of ten (10) 34

- 1 years up to the age of eighteen (18) years.
