It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 23-17.5 of the General Laws entitled "Rights of Nursing Home
- 2 Patients" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 3 <u>23-17.5-32. Prohibition from accepting patient gifts.</u>
- 4 (a) It shall be prohibited for any health care provider as defined in § 23-17.6-2 to accept
- 5 any gift with a value of more than ten dollars (\$10.00) from a nursing home patient.
- 6 (b) A health care provider who violates this section shall be liable for a civil penalty per
- 7 violation of not less than fifty dollars (\$50.00) nor to exceed five hundred dollars (\$500) which
- 8 shall be assessed and recovered in a civil action brought by the attorney general in any court of
- 9 <u>competent jurisdiction.</u>
- 10 SECTION 2. Chapter 23-17.16 of the General Laws entitled "Home Care Patient Rights"
- 11 is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:

12 **23-17.16-6.** Prohibition from accepting patient gifts.

- 13 (a) It shall be prohibited for any health care provider as defined in § 23-17.6-2 to accept
- 14 <u>any gift with a value of more than ten dollars (\$10.00) from a nursing home patient.</u>
- 15 (b) A health care provider who violates this section shall be liable for a civil penalty per
- 16 violation of not less than fifty dollars (\$50.00) nor to exceed five hundred dollars (\$500) which
- 17 shall be assessed and recovered in a civil action brought by the attorney general in any court of
- 18 competent jurisdiction.
