It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 39-18 of the General Laws entitled "Rhode Island Public Transit
- 2 Authority" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 3 **39-18-4.2.** Alteration of bus route Public hearing.
- 4 (a) Any alteration or elimination of any bus route within the system established by the
- 5 authority pursuant to § 39-18-4 shall not take effect until a public hearing is held in the
- 6 <u>neighborhood(s) along the affected route.</u>
- 7 (b) The public hearing shall take place at least thirty (30) days before the bus route
 8 change is scheduled to take effect in the neighborhood(s) along the affected route.
- 9 (c) The authority shall also prepare a neighborhood(s) impact statement prior to the
- 10 public hearing, and provide it to those persons attending the public hearing, the governor, those
- 11 members of the general assembly whose districts are affected by the change, and the mayors or
- 12 town administrators of the city or town affected by the change.
- 13 (d) Nothing in this section shall be construed to apply to any temporary alteration of a bus
- 14 route necessitated by including, but not limited to, temporary alterations occasioned by weather,
- 15 <u>construction activity, emergency, or unforeseen condition.</u>
- 16 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

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EXPLANATION

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

RELATING TO PUBLIC UTILITIES AND CARRIERS -- PUBLIC TRANSIT AUTHORITY

1 This act would require the Rhode Island public transit authority (RIPTA) to hold a public

2 hearing at least thirty (30) days prior any bus route change in the affected neighborhoods and

3 provide a neighborhood impact statement to local and state officials.

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This act would take effect upon passage.

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
