It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 34-37.1 of the General Laws entitled "Homeless Bill of Rights" is
hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:

3 34-37.1-6. Homeless persons with service animals - Homeless shelters.

Nothing in this chapter shall be construed to prohibit persons from entering a homeless shelter while in possession of a service animal as defined in the "Americans with Disabilities Act" (32 CFR 35.136) and the state and federal "Fair Housing Acts".

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
