It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 31-4-11 of the General Laws in Chapter 31-4 entitled "Transfer of Vehicles" is hereby amended to read as follows:

## 31-4-11. Sale of automobiles -- Required equipment.

- (a) No automobile shall be sold, whether new or used, by a dealer, at wholesale or retail, unless the automobile is equipped with a spare tire and a jack, both of which must be functional and operational. The provisions of this section shall not apply:
- (1) To an automobile equipped with tires that without any tire air inflation permit vehicle operation for at least fifty (50) miles at speeds up to at least fifty-five (55) miles per hour; or
- 9 (2) An automobile equipped with a factory installed tire repair and inflation system.
- 10 (b) A violation of this section (a) shall constitute a misdemeanor.
  - (c) For each sale of a new or used vehicle by a dealer, the dealer shall provide a written disclosure that the vehicle actually has a spare tire and jack or the vehicle is equipped with one of the exceptions to a spare tire and jack as provided in this section. There shall be a civil penalty of one hundred dollars (\$100) for a violation under this subsection.
- 15 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
