It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 23-17 of the General Laws entitled "Licensing of Health-Care
- 2 Facilities" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 3 **23-17-64. Influenza immunization.**
- 4 From October to March of the following year, each hospital shall offer, prior to
- 5 discharge, immunizations against influenza virus to all inpatients sixty-five (65) years of age and
- 6 <u>older, unless contraindicated, and contingent upon the availability of the vaccine, in accordance</u>
- 7 with the latest recommendations of the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices of the
- 8 Centers for Disease Control and Prevention.
- 9 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
