It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 11-22-11 of the General Laws in Chapter 11-22 entitled

2 "Highways" is hereby repealed.

3 <u>11-22-11. Testing speed of horse.</u>

4 Every person who shall drive any horse over any of the public highways, for the purpose

5 of racing or trying the speed of the horse, shall be fined not more than twenty dollars (\$20.00) or

imprisoned not exceeding ten (10) days.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
