SECTION 1. Section 11-35-15 of the General Laws in Chapter 11-35 entitled "Public

4 A copy of § 11-35-14, preceded by the word "Warning" in large type, shall be printed in

5 a prominent place in every telephone directory distributed to the members of the general public in

6 this state or in any portion of it after June 1, 1958, which lists the calling numbers of telephones

7 of any telephone exchange located in this state; provided, the provisions of this section shall not

apply to those directories distributed solely for business advertising purposes, commonly known

9 as classified directories.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
