1	WHEREAS, School Counselors across the United States, in both public and private
2	schools, work tirelessly to help students reach their full potential; and
3	WHEREAS, In consultation with parents and teachers, School Counselors work with
4	students and assist them as they explore their strengths and weaknesses, their talents, ideas,
5	values and interests, and as they chart a path towards a successful and prosperous future; and
6	WHEREAS, School Counselors also identify and seek out school and community
7	resources that will assist students in their endeavor to discover who they are and who they desire
8	to become as adults; and
9	WHEREAS, A 2013 study by the College Board calculated that adding just one
10	counselor to a high school staff produces a ten percent increase in the school's college enrollment
11	numbers. A report by the National Association for College Admission Counseling determined
12	that meeting one-on-one with a counselor to discuss financial aid for college tripled a student's
13	chances of attending college, and made it significantly more likely that they would actually apply
14	for financial aid; now, therefore be it
15	RESOLVED, That this House of Representatives of the State of Rhode Island and
16	Providence Plantations hereby proclaims the week of February 4-8, 2019, to be "National School
17	Counseling Week" in the State of Rhode Island; and be it further
