It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 39-7 of the General Laws entitled "Operation of Railroads

Generally" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:

39-7-13. Minimum number of operators on freight trains.

4 (a) No train or light engine used in connection with movement of freight may be operated

unless it has a crew of at least two (2) persons.

6 (b) Any person who willfully violates this section may be subject to a fine of not less than

7 two hundred fifty dollars (\$250), or more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000) for a first offense;

8 not less than one thousand dollars (\$1,000), or more than five thousand dollars (\$5,000) for a

9 second offense within three (3) years; and not less than five thousand dollars (\$5,000), or more

than ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) for a third offense within three (3) years.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
