It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 31-41.3 of the General Laws entitled "Automated School-Zone-

2 Speed-Enforcement System Act of 2016" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following

3 section:

31-41.3-16. Payment of violations - Restricted receipt account - School safety.

5 <u>All revenue generated by the cities or towns pursuant to this chapter from violations of</u>

6 the automated school-zone-speed-enforcement systems shall be placed in a restricted receipt

7 account to support programs designed to enhance school safety. The cities and towns operating an

8 automated school-zone-speed-enforcement system shall be entitled to deduct the reasonable

- 9 expenses associated with the operation and maintenance of the system prior to placement of any
- 10 <u>funds into the restricted receipt account.</u>
- 11 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

1 This act would require the cities and towns to place funds generated from automated

2 school-zone-speed-enforcement systems in a state operated restricted receipt account for school

- 3 safety programs.
