| 10 | a teenager who marched in President Obama's Second Inaugural Parade and was tragically shot |

| 12 | WHEREAS, To help honor Hadiya, and the 100 Americans whose lives are cut short |
| 13 | daily, and the countless others who are wounded by gun violence every day, June 7, 2019, has |
| 14 | been designated as the 5th annual National Gun Violence Awareness Day; and |
| 15 | WHEREAS, The idea for this day was inspired by a group of Hadiya's friends, who asked |
| 16 | their classmates to commemorate her life by wearing orange. They chose this color because |
| 17 | hunters wear orange to protect themselves and others, and orange is a color that has been |
| 18 | embraced by the gun safety movement because it symbolizes the value of human life; and |
