He received the award for the second time on May 23, 1991, when he 15 dove into the Providence River to save two people who were drowning; and WHEREAS, Officer Lopez leaves a legacy of devotion to duty and selfless sacrifice that 16 all public service workers seek to emulate, and he is eminently worthy of our praise and 17 18 acknowledgement.
