3 <u>12-12-1.7. Motion to dismiss information</u> Motion to dismiss information or

4 complaints.

5 Within thirty (30) days after a defendant is served with a copy of an information charging 6 him or her with an offense in the superior court or charging him or her with an offense by way of

7 <u>complaint in district court</u>, he or she may move in the superior court to dismiss the information or

8 <u>complaint</u> on the ground that the information <u>or complaint</u> and exhibits appended to it do not

9 demonstrate the existence of probable cause to believe that the offense charged has been

10 committed or that the defendant committed it. Upon the filing of the motion to dismiss the court

11 shall schedule a hearing to be held within a reasonable tim
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12 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
