It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 5-22 of the General Laws entitled "Shows and Exhibitions" is
 hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 3 **5-22-1.2. Live entertainment -- Town of Bristol.**
- 4 <u>The town council of the town of Bristol is authorized to license, regulate, or prohibit "live</u>
- 5 <u>entertainment</u>" in the town of Bristol, including, but not limited to, live performances of music or
- 6 sound by individuals, bands, musicians, disc jockeys, dancing, or karaoke, with or without
- 7 charge, provided that "incidental entertainment" be permitted as of right, and no license shall be
- 8 required. "Incidental entertainment" means background music provided at a restaurant, bar,
- 9 <u>nightclub, supper club, or similar establishment, limited to the following format:</u>
- 10 (1) Live music performance limited to no more than a maximum of three (3) acoustic
- 11 instruments that shall not be amplified by any means, electronic or otherwise; or
- 12 (2) Prerecorded music or streamed music played over a permanently installed sound
- 13 system. If a bar or restaurant includes incidental entertainment, it cannot charge a cover charge;
- 14 shall not allow dancing by patrons of the establishment; cannot employ flashing, laser, or strobe
- 15 lights; and the maximum volume, irrespective of the format, is limited solely to the boundaries of
- 16 the premises at all times, and shall permit audible conversation among patrons of the
- 17 <u>establishment.</u>

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
